# REGULATION OF THE FINANCE MINISTER NUMBER 151/ PMK.011 / 2009 ON

# THE IMPOSITION OF SAFEGUARD TARIFF

# ON THE IMPORT OF NAILS

# THE FINANCE MINISTER,

Having considered	:	a. that based on the results of the investigation of the Indonesian Safeguard Committee which show that in the period of investigation (2005- Semester I of 2008) there was a significant increase in the imported goods investigated which led to a serious loss to the domestic industry, the Trade Minister by letter Number: 1062/M-DAG/7/2009 proposed the imposition of Safeguard Tariff on the import of nails with the Tariff Code 7317.00.10.00;
		b. that based on the provision of Article 21 of the Presidential Decree Number 84 of 2002 on the Safeguard Measures for Domestic Industry as a Result of Sharp Increase in Imports, the safeguard measures in the form of Tariff may be implemented by the Finance Minister;
		<ul> <li>c. that based on the considerations as referred to in letter a and letter b and in order to implement the provision of Article 23 D paragraph (2) of Law Number 10 of 1995 on Customs as amended by Law Number 17 of 2006, it is necessary to enact the Regulation of the Finance Minister on the Imposition of Safeguard Tariff on the Import of Nails;</li> </ul>

#### Article 1

On the import of types of nails with the tariff code 7317.00310.00 a Safeguard Tariff shall be imposed

#### Article 2

The Safeguard Tariff as referred to in Article 1 shall be imposed on the importation from all countries, except on nails produced and imported from countries as set forth in the Appendix of this Regulation of the Finance Minister, which constitutes an integral part of this Regulation of the Finance Minister.

#### Article 3

- (1) The imposition of Safeguard Tariff as referred to in Article 1 shall constitute:
  - a. additional general tariff (Most Favored Nation); or
  - b. additional preferential tariff pursuant to international agreements on the trade of goods applicable if the import is from countries participating in those international agreements on the trade of goods.
- (2) In the event that the international agreements on the trade of goods do not provide that, the imposition of safeguard tariff as referred to in paragraph (1) letter b shall constitute the addition general tariff (Most Favored Nation).

#### Article 4

On the import of nails from countries exempted from the Safeguard Tariff as referred to in Article 2 and countries given a special treatment as referred to in Article 3 paragraph (1) letter b, importers shall submit the Certificate of Origin.

#### Article 5

The Safeguard Tariff rates as referred to in Article 1 imposed for 3 (three) years shall be as follows:

Period	Safeguard Tariff
$1^{st}$ Year : 1 October 2009 to	145 %
30 September 2010	
$2^{nd}$ Year : 1 October 2010 to	115 %
30 September 2011	
$3^{rd}$ Year : 1 October 2011 to	85 %
30 September 2012	



### FINANCE MINISTER THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA Article 6

The Safeguard Tariff rates as referred to in Article 5 shall generally apply to the import of goods with an import declaration which has obtained a registration number from the customs office in the port of entry of goods as of the date this Regulation of the Finance Minister becomes effective.

### Article 7

- 1. This Regulation of the Finance Minister shall be effective as of the date of its promulgation.
- 2. This Regulation of the Finance Minister shall be effective for 3 (three) years calculated from the date of the promulgation of this Regulation of the Finance Minister as referred to in number 1.

In order that this Regulation be known to the general public, it is hereby ordered that this Regulation be promulgated in the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia.
